

Step by step tick removal







1

Track down that tick.
Check the least hairy
areas first, such as the
face, neck, under belly
and inside of legs.

Arm yourself with the right tick twister, depending on the size of the tick.





Wear gloves to avoid direct contact with the tick.

Bring the tick twister in from the side.

Hook the tick's body.

Gently lift the hook while rotating the twister.

Rotate 2-3 times and the tick should release itself from your pet.


Place the tick into a container filled with alcohol. Keep this as your vet may need to see this later.





4

Use antiseptic to clean the affected area on your pet.







Be mindful of the area where the tick was attached to your pet's skin.

Book an appointment to see one of our vets if the skin becomes irritated or infected.
